Summary & Resources - Salamander Springs Farm July 2022 OAK Farmer Field Day



Intensive Cover Crop Methods for No-till Production of Staple Crops and Vegetables

Visiting Salamander Springs Farm's steep hillside during a series of downpours (as Field Day participants did in July) accentuates the take-home message from host farmer Susana Lein: keeping living roots in the soil at all times and disturbing the soil structure as little as possible help to build the soil organic matter that makes erosion a non-issue. Having suffered weeks of drought, Susana's hillside was still lush and green. Susana commented, "It's not how much rain falls from the sky; it's how much you hold in the soil." Imitating a prairie (or a forest), she explained, is now nature built soil - and how she manages her continual year-round cover crop - relay cropping systems. In tandem with contour farming and intentional water management, such as swales and making use of wet areas for rice production(!), Susana incorporates permaculture principles, Mayan farming practices and continual observation for a truly regenerative farmstead.
